Risk	Measures to Minimise Risk
Injury while climbing equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full safety brief before using equipment • Ensure instructors have relevant training • Ensure effective group control and supervision • Remove footwear before using equipment • Remove all loose clothing and jewellery before using equipment • Ensure ratios are maintained • All equipment checked before starting session
Injury whilst descending equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure long sleeves, trousers and socks are worn at all times • Clear instructions to go sitting feet first only • Ensure only one person at a time on the slide • Crash mat placed at bottom of slide
Falling Objects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Empty pockets before ascending • Clear no go zone for non climbers
Unsupervised or Unauthorised Use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lower tower after use • Lock in secure compound when not in use.
Equipment Failure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure equipment is maintained by trained staff • Ensure checks are done before operating • Spider mountain to be serviced once a year.



Petrol Blower	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure maintenance is carried out by trained staff • In case of fire have extinguisher on hand • Surround with safety cage
Electric Blower	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tripping over cables – ensure cables are covered over/coned off • Electric shock-ensure electrical equipment is well maintained
