Getting Lost	Participants Volunteers Staff	 Full safety brief given Prior to Activity starting. Clear Operational area shown to participants prior to Activity starting. Participants provided with map, whistle and Centre phone number. Participants to report to an instructor at regular intervals throughout the Activity Instructors at regular intervals over the course to assist participants.
Slips and trips	Participants Volunteers Staff	 Full Safety brief given prior to Activity starting. Where participants are out of sight, groups of three are maintained at all times. Operational area checked for hazards prior to Activity starting. Ensure Instructors hold relevant First Aid qualification.
Medical conditions	Participants Volunteers Instructors	 Ensure all medical requirements are understood by staff Continuous supervision by Instructors and if participants are out of sight, they are to be in groups of 3 minimum. Ensure all instructors hold a relevant first aid qualification. At least one instructor per group to carry a working radio at all times, and completed a radio check with the Duty Manager/Senior Instructor.
