Slips, Trips and Falls	Participants, Instructors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instructors to check activity area prior to use. • Full safety brief to be given prior to start of activity. • Instructor supervision required at all times.
Structure collapsing during construction	Participants, Instructors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full safety brief to be given prior to start of activity. • Helmets to be worn while erecting the structure. • Instructor to assist in erecting the structure, and ensure that it is secure before allowing activity to progress. • Participants briefed to not climb or swing on the structure. • Instructor supervision required at all times.
Struck by Projectile or the slingshot cradle	Participants, Instructors, Third Parties	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full safety brief given prior to start of activity and again before firing. • Instructor to set up and the firing range and ensure it is cleared of people before firing. • Participants to load the slingshot from the side and not the front. • Participants only to test the firing mechanism once the instructor has cleared them to do so. • Instructor supervision required at all times.
Other Injuries	Participants, Instructors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Full safety brief given prior to start of activity • Instructors to check kit prior to use, for hazards that may cause injury. • Correct manual Handlung to be used when moving poles around. • Two minors must carry short poles, and three to carry long poles. • Participants must communicate clearly before picking up poles and putting them back down. • Instructor supervision required at all times.
