(Face Masks should not be worn in the water)</li> <li>If an instructor needs to make an adjustment to a sailing dinghy, the participant should face away from the instructor at the opposite end of the boat.</li> <li>Hand sanitiser available around site and in the powerboats.</li> </ul> |
