Drowning	Participants Volunteers Instructors	<ul> <li>Full safety brief given prior to the start of Activity.</li> <li>Ensure instructors have the training to deal with rescue and recovery techniques.</li> <li>Instructor(s) to hold relevant first aid qualification.</li> <li>Member of staff on land, trained in calling the emergency services, and first aid.</li> <li>At least one Instructor per group to have a radio and carry out a radio check with Duty Manager/Senior Instructor</li> <li>All participants instructed that they must always hold on</li> </ul>
Falling out	Participants Instructors	<ul> <li>Full safety briefing given prior to the start of Activity.</li> <li>Appropriate clothing and buoyancy aids to be worn by all participants.</li> <li>Instructors trained to deal with the situation.</li> <li>Instructors to hold relevant first aid qualification.</li> <li>Member of staff on land, trained on calling the emergency services, and first aid.</li> <li>All participants instructed that they must always hold on</li> </ul>
Collisions with other craft	Participants Instructors Other water users	<ul> <li>Full safety briefing given prior to start of activity.</li> <li>Participants instructed to avoid collisions at all costs from the start.</li> <li>Ensure instructor ratios are maintained.</li> <li>Powerboat area to be set prior to going afloat.</li> </ul>
Injuries sustained on the water	Participants Volunteers Instructors	<ul> <li>Full safety briefing given prior to start of activity.</li> <li>Safety pack in all powerboats containing first aid kit.</li> <li>All participants to wear suitable clothing, footwear and buoyancy aids.</li> <li>Instructors hold relevant first aid qualification.</li> <li>Member of staff on land, trained in calling the emergency services, and first aid contactable by radio.</li> </ul>



Man Overboard Manoeuvre Teaching	Participants Instructors	<ul> <li>Full safety briefing given prior to start of activity.</li> <li>Safety pack in all powerboats containing first aid kit.</li> <li>Ensure instructor ratios are maintained.</li> <li>Ensure all hold points are attached and in working condition.</li> <li>All manoeuvres are practiced at slow speed.</li> <li>All participants instructed that they must always hold on</li> </ul>
Manual Handling Ashore	Participants Volunteers Instructors Casual Staff	<ul> <li>Full safety briefing given prior to start of activity.</li> <li>Manual handling guidelines to be always followed.</li> <li>Instructors and Casual Staff trained in the relevant manual handling procedures.</li> <li>Instructors to have a relevant first aid qualification.</li> </ul>
Moving the powerboats with the tractor	Participants Volunteers Instructors Casual Staff Members of the public	<ul> <li>Full safety briefing given prior to start of activity.</li> <li>Full training provided to the instructor driving the tractor.</li> <li>Hazard lights and beacon to be always on when tractor is in motion.</li> <li>A spotter to help guid the tractor when reversing the powerboat trailer.</li> <li>Public and participants asked to stay clear of tractor and trailer</li> </ul>
Fuel	Participants Volunteers Instructors Casual Staff Members of the public	<ul> <li>The fuel to be in a sealed container.</li> <li>In Date and tested fire extinguisher to be present in the boat.</li> <li>Participants to be instructed on what to do in case of a fire.</li> <li>Fuel lines to be checked prior to launch.</li> </ul>
