Risk	Who Might Be Harmed	Measures to Minimise Risk
Injury sustained whilst carrying, lifting or manoeuvrin g craft.	Participants Volunteers Staff	 Full safety brief given prior to activity starting. When carrying the kayaks work in pairs. Instructors close by to assist if necessary. Instructors trained in manual handling.
Entrapment under capsized craft	Participants Volunteers Staff	 Full safety brief given and capsize drill demonstrated on land prior to going afloat. Ensure instructors have good group control and effective supervision at all times. Ensure all Instructors are Trained to deal with Entrapment situations.
Injury afloat	Participant Volunteers Staff	 Helmets to be worn if under 18's. Over 18's advised to wear a helmet, but it is their own choice not to wear one. Good group control and constant supervision by the instructor. Full safety brief given prior to activity starting including risks involved with the paddles and boat. Safety poster to be read by casual hire users prior to going afloat. Safety boat on the water ready to assist if needed.
Loss of control in strong winds	Participants Volunteers	 Safety boat on the water ready to assist. Instructor to use the safest area/sheltered area where possible.

Drowning	Participants Volunteers Staff	 Full safety brief given prior to activity starting. Correct safety and rescue techniques taught. Continuous and effective supervision by instructors. Correct clothing and buoyancy aids worn. Ensure all medical requirements of students are understood by staff. Ensure all staff have the correct first aid training.

Medical conditions	Participants Volunteers Instructors	 Ensure all medical requirements are understood by staff Continuous supervision by Instructors Ensure all instructors hold a relevant first aid qualification. At least one instructor per group to carry a working radio at all times, and completed a radio check with the Duty Manager/Senior Instructor
